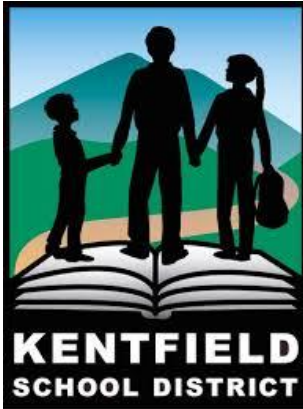


Five Key Areas

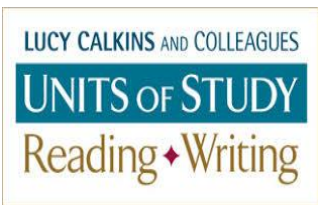
