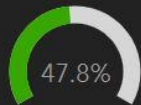

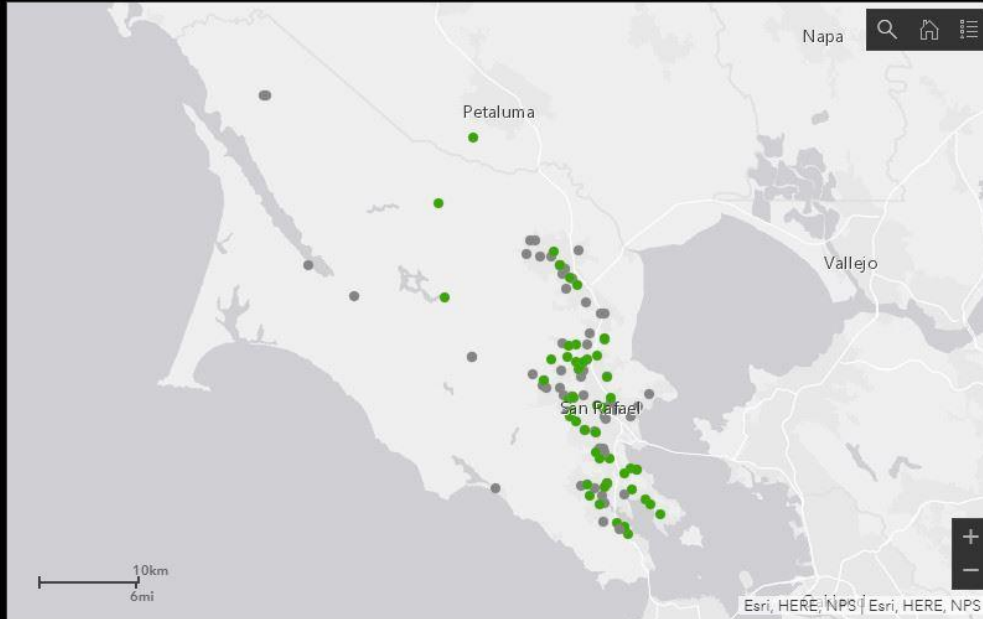

# Transition to In-Person Instruction

## Phasing Status:

- KSD Hybrid Instruction - Nov. 12
  - 11/2 agreement to have cohorts of 8 students
  - KSD - KTA Tours - Meet & Confer, Friday 11/6
- Staffing Adjustments
  - Accommodations and Leaves
  - Prioritizing stability for students
- Notification to Families from School Sites - cohorts, schedule and logistical information

# KSD Student Experience

A Day in the Life

## Key Components:

Plan is One (1) week In-Person, Once (1) week Distance Learning

Daily schedule will remain the same for both cohorts: 8:30-12:00 (K); 8:30-1:00 (1-4); 9:00-1:30 (5-8)

Schedules will be staggered - arrival/dismissal, recess/snack, etc.

***Distance Learning program will adapt with a Hybrid approach***

Continue opportunity for small group instruction

Increased social interaction with peers
