Dear Parents / Guardians of Vaccinated Children (5 – 11-year-olds):

This letter is to ensure that parents of children vaccinated against COVID-19 have the necessary information to complete their child's two-dose vaccination series.

Thanks to you, currently 51% of Marin County 5 – 11-year-olds have received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. This is the highest rate in the state of California.

At this time, your child should have an appointment scheduled for their 2nd dose at the same vaccine clinic location 3 – 6 weeks after their first dose. The back of the vaccine card has the date you should return for a 2nd dose. If your child does not have a 2nd dose appointment, please schedule one at any vaccine clinic location. 2nd dose appointments must be 21 days after the first dose. Visit <https://coronavirus.marinhhs.org/vaccinefinder> to make a 2nd dose appointment.

After taking the above steps, if you are unable to obtain a second dose appointment please email COVID19vaccine@marincounty.org.

Unless they were vaccinated at school, vaccinated children should also have received their [CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card](#). If they were vaccinated at school, our team will be giving them their vaccination record card after they receive their 2nd dose.

If your child was vaccinated at a community vaccine clinic, please bring this card back to the vaccine clinic when your child receives their 2nd dose. After your child receives their 2nd dose, take a digital photo of the front and back of the card and save digital copies to your phone and/or personal cloud storage. Do not laminate this card. In the future, their vaccination record may need to be updated with booster dose information.
