- 2. Approval of Agenda The agenda was unanimously approved
- 3. Approval of Minutes The minutes from January 11, 2017, were unanimously approved
- 4. Membership Update Tracy Coombe will be the 7th member of the COC. We continue to recruit a member of a taxpayers group for a seat on the committee. Liz Schott invited Mimi Willard, founder of CO\$TMarin but received no response.
- 5. Liz Schott explained to the committee that expected increases in enrollment as predicted by the District's 2014 demographic study have not materialized. There is a gap of almost 200 students next year between expected enrollment and actual. For this reason, the School Board has decided not to move 4th grade to Kent at this time, and will consider at its April 18, 2017, Board Meeting if any new classrooms are needed at Kent. Modernization and security/safety improvements will proceed as planned on both campuses, and the replacement of the round building at Bacich will still occur.
