The combined assigned and unassigned ending fund balances that are in excess of the minimum recommended reserve for economic uncertainties for each fiscal year identified in the budget; and

A statement of reasons to substantiate the need for reserves that are higher than the minimum recommended reserve.

A 'Special Education Reserve' has been established for unforeseen special education program costs, and the 'Undesignated Reserve' for enrollment growth and staffing needs. needs, and possible unforseen deferred maintenance costs.
